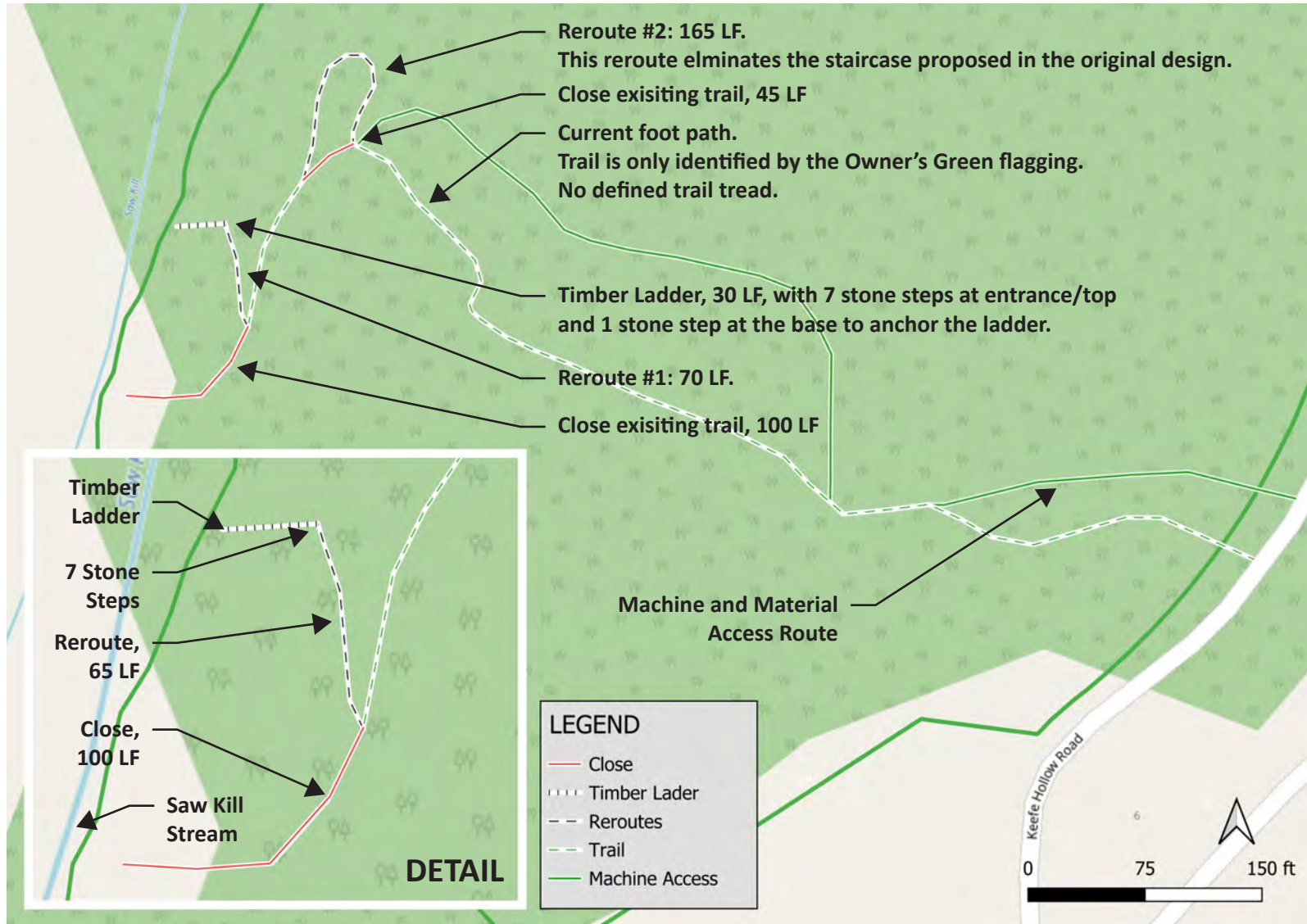

OVERVIEW:

This is a revision to the design document that was created on 08/20/2025. (2) reroutes are being proposed to help reduce the timber ladder height, these reroutes also help to eliminate the proposed stone staircases in the original design. 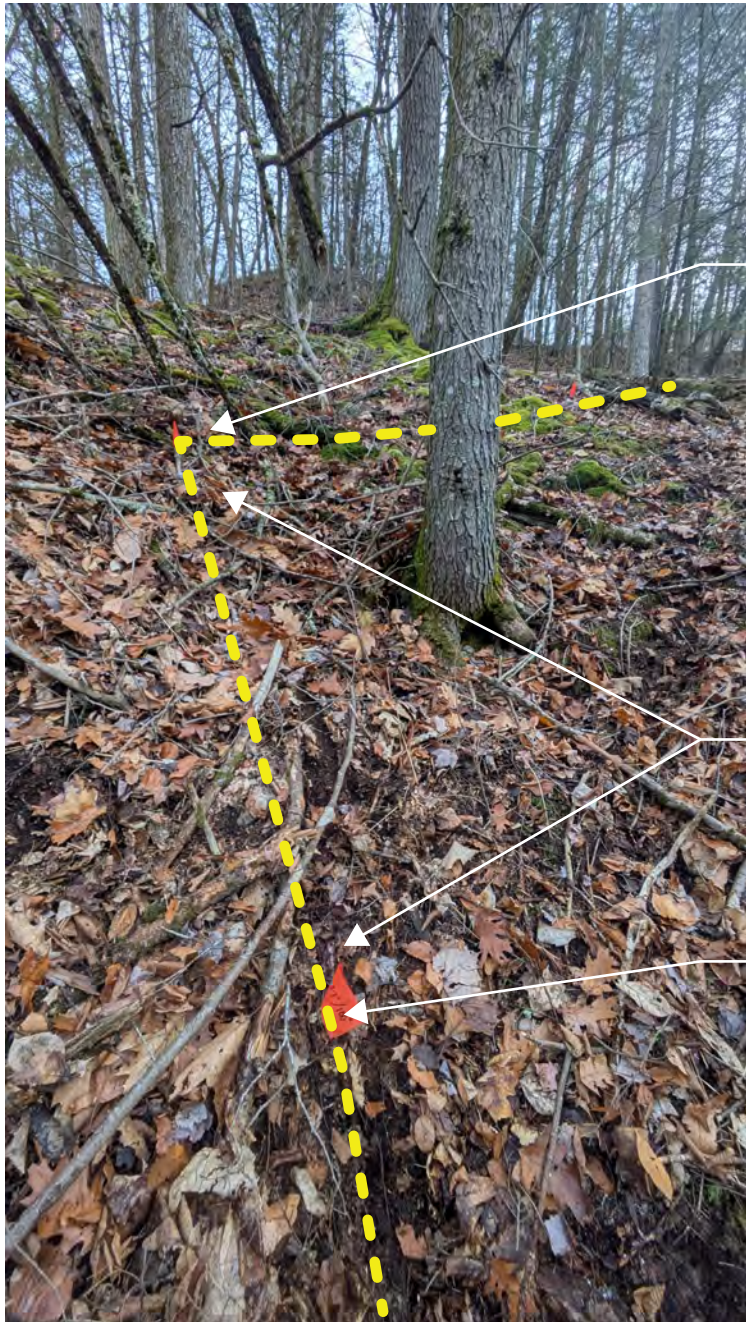
