The Board of Assessment Review will meet on Tuesday May 26th from 3PM-8PM at the Comeau Building, 45 Comeau Drive, Woodstock, NY. There will be a dinner break from 5PM-6PM. The BAR will accept grievance applications and will hear and examine all complaints in relation to assessments on all real property within the Town of Woodstock. Per real property tax law, all grievance applications must be filed with the Board of Assessment Review on or before Grievance Day, May 26th. Grievance appointments may be made by calling the assessor's office at (845) 679-2113, line 11.
