Service: New York

Birth: May 1741 New Paltz, New York

Death: October 8, 1791 Woodstock, New York

DAR Service Description: Hasbrouck served with COL JAMES CLINTON, 3RD NY REGT

June 1775 Hasbrouck received commission as Captain in the 3rd NY Regt.

Captain Hasbrouck served at Fort Ticonderoga from June 28 through September 28, 1775

November, 30, 1775 Captain Elias Hasbrouck received orders from Major General Philip Schuyler to recruit more men.

Hasbrouck was in command of a company of rangers while serving with Major General Richard Montgomery in Quebec during which time Montgomery was killed in action, December 31, 1775.

Elias Hasbrouck and Elizabeth Sleight Hasbrouck are parents of seven children:

Elias, John, Daniel, Montgomery (Richard), Peter, Elizabeth and Sara.

They were all born on the Hasbrouck farm in Lake Hill, town of Woodstock, N.Y.
