Resolution 108-2026

Resolution Creating and Appointing Flood Advisory Committee and Members

Offered by Supervisor Courtis, seconded by Council Member Ricci.

WHEREAS, the Town Board recognizes that meaningful local knowledge, technical input, and community participation will strengthen the accuracy and usefulness of the Local Flood Analysis and any resulting recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of an advisory body will assist the Town Board and Town staff in evaluating flooding issues and potential flood mitigation strategies;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Supervisor of the Town of Woodstock hereby establishes a Flood Advisory Committee, to serve as an advisory body to the Town Board and Town staff in connection with flooding issues, flood mitigation strategies, and the Local Flood Analysis work; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Flood Advisory Committee shall serve in a purely advisory capacity, shall have no authority to bind the Town, and shall make findings and recommendations to the Town Board as requested; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following individuals are hereby appointed to the Flood Advisory Committee as volunteer members for an initial term ending December 31, 2026, with the option of renewal for successive one-year terms by vote of the Town Board:
