

Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum made and executed this ^{26th} day of *April* 1978,
between the

Reformed Protestant Dutch Church of Woodstock, New York,
hereinafter referred to as the Church, and the

Town of Woodstock, Ulster County and State of New York,
hereinafter referred to as the Town.

WHEREAS, the Church has previously voted to grant an easement to the Town for sidewalk purposes by resolution of the Consistory dated March 1, 1978, and

WHEREAS, the Church and the Town mutually desire to reaffirm their understanding as to the use, occupation and control of the premises owned by the Church and subject to the easement in favor of the Town, it is therefore

Understood that the Church and the Town mutually agree.

1. Notwithstanding any previous or present easements granted by the Church in favor of the Town, fee title remains in the Church.
2. The use and occupation of the area known as the Village Green and the area between the Village Green and other lands of the Church shall continue to be the subject of exclusive joint control between the Church and the Town.
3. Nothing herein shall obligate the Church, however, ~~too~~ exercise any affirmative duty or obligation with regard to the premises subject to the easement and the Town will indemnify and save harmless the Church against any claims or losses brought or suffered by third parties.
4. The Church may continue to use the sidewalk and the roadway areas in the same manner as previously enjoyed.
