### **Task Force Member Role Description**

Woodstock's Climate Smart Communities Task Force is leading efforts to reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions and build climate resilience. We are seeking one additional member to support our efforts to plan for a climate smart future. As a statewide program, Climate Smart Communities, helps municipalities build climate resilience by giving them support to complete resilience and GHG emissions reductions actions. This support often comes in the form of grants. As a Task Force member you will work with the town government, residents, and local businesses to identify projects and create plans for both reducing GHG emissions and building climate resilience. In 2026 we are renewing our Bronze status, building out a new Community Climate Action Plan for GHG emissions reductions, and completing our Drinking Water Source Protection plan, as well as considering further improvements and a focus on future Silver status.

- Knowledge or keen interest in green energy solutions and / or flood resilience and / or environmental best practices.
- Attention to detail. You love dotting the i's and crossing the t's. The CSC program has strict detailed requirements for submissions.
- Interest and ability to take action and write plans and / or educational materials
- Graphic design expertise to produce informational, educational, and outreach materials
